Cutcombe Machinery & Poultry Sale

Exmoor Farmers received a large entry of small tools machinery and poultry for the sale on Friday afternoon at Cutcombe market. The entry included a selection of farm machinery from Beasley Farm by kind instruction of Mrs Edwards-Heathcote. This sold strongly with the P Reg John Deere 6200 Tractor and Loader making £10,250 and Muck spreader reaching £1600. A post knocker from the same home sold to £780. Other entries included an Ifor Williams stock box from Mr J Tucker, Stetfold Rocks which reached £520 and a ménage roller from Messrs Knight selling for £300.

Poultry sold exceptionally well with a trade leaving vendors very pleased. Blue Marans were in demand with many point of lay (pol) birds selling for £14. Light Sussex pol sold to £15 and a pair of pol Black Rock made £23. Wellsummers peaked at £27 for a pair of pol. A cream Legbar hen with 10 chicks reached £25 and a second hen with 9 chicks made £38.

Ducks as always were well represented also with call ducks making upwards of £7 each. Two female lavender blue call ducks sold for £9. Aylesbury ducks again to £7 each and two female Saxony ducks made £8.
